Reconfirmation Meeting for December

Reconfirm instructional delivery method:
Face to face unless the family elects remote learning or the IEP Team determines the student is homebound/hospitalized.
Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:
Elementary (Grades K - 5): Face to face unless the family elects remote learning or the IEP Team determines the student is homebound/hospitalized.
Middle School (Grades 6 - 8): Face to face unless the family elects remote learning or the IEP Team determines the student is homebound/hospitalized.
High School (Grades 9 - 12): Face to face unless the family elects remote learning or the IEP Team determines the student is homebound/hospitalized.
Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:
We offer face to face for all students.
Document Public Comments:
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Week 4 covered Thanksgiving break and the students were only in session for 2 days. In person attendance was 87% and 21% of students had two two-way interactions.

Week 2 (11/11-11/17)	74%
Week 3 (11/18-11/24)	75%
Week 4 (11/25-12/1)	54%
