



WOOD SHOP/INDUSTRIAL ARTS TEACHER

Dollar Bay-Tamarack City Area Schools is seeking a part-time high school woods/industrial arts teacher, starting September 2021.

Qualifications:

- Valid Michigan Teaching Certificate with proper endorsement for teaching woods/industrial arts in Grades 6-12 or qualifications to be alternately certified (including substantial professional experience in the field of Woodworking)
- Strong knowledge of industrial arts/woodworking content
- Significant experience working with wood shop tools and equipment
- Interest in and confidence working with middle/high school students
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills

Responsibilities:

- Teach General Woodworking/Industrial Arts to high school students for one 76-minute period per day
- Effectively manage student behavior, ensure students are actively engaged in learning/work, and maintain positive classroom climate
- Ensure that safety is maintained at all times in the Wood Shop
- Employ Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) practices
- Teach students, from beginning to advanced levels, various woodworking skills, and help them choose and complete appropriate projects
- Manage budget, including student payments for woods and materials required for student projects
- Maintain shop equipment and ensure shop environment is kept clean
- Maintain positive relationships with students and staff
